

Privacy Policy

1. SUMMARY

Brief: By sending us information through the registration form on <https://www.gdcc.tech> or email, you agree that we may store and use this information for the purposes of the competition.

Detailed: You give your consent to the personal data operator — Faculty of Computational Mathematics and Cybernetics of Moscow State University (the registered actual location address: 119991, Moscow, Russia, Leninskie Gory 1/52, Faculty of Computational Mathematics and Cybernetics 2nd educational building) as the Organizer of the Global Data Compression Competition (GDCC) 2021, to collect and transfer your personal data. “We” and “us” in this policy mean the Organizer.

We collect your contact details which allow us to identify and contact you directly, such as your name, and email address. This policy explains how the Organizer of the GDCC 2021 may use the personal data you disclose to it.

For the purposes of data protection legislation, the Organizer will be the controller of the personal data collected by it. Your personal data will be treated in accordance with our Privacy Policy, as set out below.

2. WHAT WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA FOR

- Verifying you are eligible to join the competition and receive prizes
- Internal management
- Contacting you during this competition and after it for the purpose of discussing your submissions and any questions associated with the competition including transfer of prize money
- To comply with our legal obligations

The Organizer and the companies receiving your personal data may process them in the following ways: record, classify, collect, store, make the information more accurate (update, modify), extract, use, block, delete, erase, and provide their employees with access to the personal data, disclosure to other persons if it's necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes.

Your personal data may be processed in a mixed way — in the non-automated mode and in the automated mode and the received information may be transferred via Internet.

Where you have given the Organizer your consent to use your personal data in a particular manner you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time. Please note however that the withdrawal of your consent will not affect any use of the data made before you withdrew your consent; nor does it affect any data processing based on another justification other than your consent.

3. TRANSFERRING YOUR PERSONAL DATA INTERNATIONALLY

The Organizer may share your personal data with competition sponsor Huawei Technologies Co., Ltd (the registered actual location address: 121614, Moscow, Krylatskaya str., bld.17, block 2) in particular regarding payments of prize money.

Huawei is a global company, which means the Organizer may transfer your personal data to Huawei's affiliated companies, some of which are outside EU. Huawei will ensure that your data is adequately protected by all applicable legal and regulatory requirements and will take action to ensure that the data we have collected will be processed in compliance with this policy and with local law. However, your personal data may be transmitted as the cross-border transfer to China, which is a state that does not provide adequate protection for the rights of personal data subjects.

4. HOW LONG IS THE PERSONAL DATA KEPT FOR

The Organizer will keep your personal data for no longer than is necessary for the purposes of conducting the competition (until January 2022). The Organizer takes appropriate physical, organizational, and technical measures to protect your personal data from unauthorized access or use, improper disclosure, tampering, destruction, or loss.
